Sunshine Meadows starts to take shape!



As one drives into the town of Dundurn, Sunshine Meadows is coming along nicely as the owner of the development is currently focusing on the north end commercial portion and the outdoor / perimeter work. The outdoor work should be completed by the end of September and the north commercial area completed in

the next couple of weeks which will be contracted out to begin building a 10 bay commercial venue.
Currently, Sunshine Meadows has 104 out of 265 lots serviced.
One of the main features of the development is the lake. Surrounding the Lake is a rubberized pathway which has some bounce making it easier

on the body when walking or jogging, solar powered lighting, kids park, and a winter building. Plans are to stock the lake with trout for the summer and add more water in the winter for an ice rink. There will be four entrances to the lake area with each lane named according to the trees that are planted along the pathway.

I was pleased to attend the celebrations in Dundurn on July 1, participate in the parade and take part in the festivities.

Latest from the Legislature:

Our government has worked hard to increase the complement of physicians and specialists in Saskatchewan through training,

retention, and international recruitment.

The Saskatchewan International Physician Practice Assessment is a made-in-Saskatchewan solution created to assess foreign-trained family physicians.

Sixteen doctors recently completed the assessment.

As a result of this program, which was fully implemented in 2012, 210 more physicians are serving Saskatchewan with 80% practicing in a rural or regional community.

Since 2007, Saskatchewan has welcomed over 750 more doctors to communities throughout Saskatchewan, which means a better experience for patients across the system. There is still more work to do and we're going


to continue our efforts to ensure Saskatchewan patients have even better access to health care.

Meanwhile, as part of our commitment to investing in local infrastructure, we are working to improve access to modern, reliable water and wastewater services, The Government's of Canada and Saskatchewan recently announced funding for 75 Saskatchewan projects.

Since 2007, our government has invested more than \$350 million in municipal infrastructure projects across the province. This is in addition to nearly \$258 million in revenue sharing—unconditional funding provided to municipalities to invest in local priorities.




