

**TOWN OF DUNDURN  
BYLAW 2017-05**


**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM MILL RATE AND MINIMUM  
TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 289 OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT**

The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The uniform mill rate shall be established at 10.00 mills
2. A minimum tax of \$1,100.00 shall be applied to all residential property with taxable improvements upon it.
3. A minimum tax of \$550.00 shall be applied to all residential land.
4. A minimum tax of \$1,000.00 shall be applied to all commercial land.
5. A minimum tax of \$1,000.00 shall be applied to all agricultural land.
6. That if a property is assessed for COMMERCIAL and RESIDENTIAL, the assessor shall apply the minimum tax to the assessment which corresponds to the zoning of the property.
7. Bylaw 2016-03 is hereby repealed.
