BYLAW NO 2012-6

TOWN OF DUNDURN

A BYLAW TO REQUIRE EVERY MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANDIDATE TO SUBMIT A CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK

The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the provision of Section 89.1, *The Municipalities Act &* Section 63.1, *The Cities Act*, enacts as follows:

- 1. It shall be lawful to require every person submitting their nomination for the position of Mayor or Councillor to provide a criminal record check in addition to the nomination paper submitted pursuant to section 46 of *The Local Government Elections Act* at their own expense.
- 2. No nomination shall be deemed complete and accepted by the returning officer without the criminal record check.
- Criminal record checks shall be in the form provided by the local RCMP detachment and shall display signature of commanding officer, date and seal.
- 4. Criminal record checks shall not be more than 3 months old at time of submission.
- 5. The returning officer or nomination officer shall post in conspicuous place copies of the nominations received and accompanying documentation.
- 6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading by Council.
