Concrete or blocks can be taken to Lafarge @ 71st Street West (by PBR) for disposal for FREE. They will also take asphalt shingles for a fee.

All users of curbside waste and recycling pick up, are reminded to bring in their bins as soon as possible after collection. Not only does it hinder street/grass maintenance but any costs related to damages or replacement due to bins being left out at the curb is the responsibility of the property owner.
