

**TOWN OF DUNDURN
BYLAW 2018-05**

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM MILL RATE AND MINIMUM
TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 289 OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT**


The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The uniform mill rate shall be established at 10.00 mills
2. A minimum tax of \$1,100.00 shall be applied to all residential property with taxable improvements upon it.
3. A minimum tax of \$600.00 shall be applied to all residential land.
4. A minimum tax of \$1,100.00 shall be applied to all commercial land.
5. A minimum tax of \$1,100.00 shall be applied to all agricultural land.
6. That if a property is assessed for COMMERCIAL and RESIDENTIAL, the assessor shall apply the minimum tax to the assessment which corresponds to the zoning of the property.
7. The minimum tax shall be applied to all separately assessed and buildable titled lots, except where part of an existing primary building may encroach upon it, in which it is grandfathered until the building is demolished.
8. Bylaw 2017-05 is hereby repealed.
