



Any pictures you may have that are of the town or an event, please submit to the Town Office.


July is over, and we are in mid summer. I see many children enjoying the spray park which is great to see. Also families are making use of a great outdoor pool located at the Dundurn Military Base.

THE NINTH ANNUAL (2015) BLACKSTRAP ART STUDIO TOUR SUMMARY

The ninth annual Blackstrap Art Studio Tour has been successfully completed. The tour involved 20 individual artists as well as multiple participants at the Hot Shop and the Dundurn Elementary School Students. Three new artists joined the ranks although not all joined in time to be listed in the pamphlet. A variety of other individuals were involved in hostess/information duties.

The three sites included the Dundurn Elementary School, Dundurn Wilson Museum and Hiebert's Hot Shop. Demonstrations and information sessions were available to the public for 8 hours Saturday and 5 hours Sunday. All venues were free.

Wagon Wheel signs directed the public to the various sites. Evaluation data collected during the tour was complimentary. People learned about the event from a variety of advertizing initiatives: word of mouth, pamphlets, and the CBC and CTV Morning Live productions. Painted signs placed at key sites gave advance notice of the event.

Three to four hundred visitors are estimated to have participated in the Tour. Visitors who received door prizes donated by the artists are listed below.

The organizers and artists wish to thank the Town, the Councillors of the Town, and the R.M of Dundurn for their support including the Lotteries Grant from the Dundurn and District Recreation Board. Rules for Driving an ATV by SGI

You can drive an ATV on Crown land, including highway right of ways.

You can only drive an ATV on the travelled portion of a road or street, in the following circumstances:

- » On a road or street authorized by a local bylaw;
- » On a road or street authorized by the Highway Traffic Board (HTB); or
- » When crossing a road or bridge (unless prohibited by local bylaw or the HTB).

To drive an ATV on private land, you need the permission of the owner or occupant.

Exceptions

Both the HTB and your local municipality may prohibit the operation of ATVs on:

- » Untraveled portions of highways (i.e. ditches, or medians),
- » Crown land, and
- » Private or municipal land.

Look for signs indicating permission, prohibition or restriction.

FIRE BAN FOR NORTHERN SASKATCHEWAN NOW LIFTED

As of July 17, 2015

The Ministry of Environment, in consultation with the Ministry of Parks, Culture and Sport, has lifted the ban on open fires that was put into effect June 25, 2015. Effective immediately, the ban is rescinded for all provincial forests, and for all provincial parks and recreation sites located within these forests.

Recent rainfall and cooler temperatures have reduced wildfire hazards. The improved conditions and reduced wildfire threats have made it possible for the ministry to lift the ban. These include the Canwood, Fort à la Corne, Nisbet, Northern, Porcupine and Torch River provincial forests, and Candle Lake, Great Blue Heron, Lac La Ronge, Meadow Lake, Makwa Lake and Narrow Hills provincial parks, and Bronson Forest and Chitek Lake recreation sites.


Please be aware that the Rural Municipality of Dundurn may still have their own fire bans in place; check with the RM Office to find out if other bans apply in your area.

If you burn, check wind and weather conditions before you start your fire, don't leave it unattended and make sure it's dead out before you leave it.

The Town of Dundurn wishes to advise residents to take care when using wood burning fire pits ensuring that the pit is covered to eliminate flying sparks and that there is a sufficient supply of water nearby. It is recommended if possible to use only propane or natural gas fireplaces, fire bowls or pits.

<u>Dundurn Sports Centre Ice & Rink Maintenance/Janitorial Attendant – October 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016:</u>

- Responsible for ice making, rink set-up, maintenance of skating ice, facility, spectator area, change rooms, washrooms, and the general area of the rink,
- Working with the Town Foreman for inspection and maintenance of ice plant and buildings,
- Liaison/contact person with all maintenance contractors including the Zamboni repair company,
- Clean and empty trash in ice viewing area, tractor room and player's bench area,
- Removal of snow and ice from all doors and exits,
- Minor maintenance (bulbs, etc.), ensure exhaust fans are running when cleaning the ice,
- Open/Close rink, must be available for the duration of rentals to monitor the safety and security
 of the facility,
- Duties include **daily** cleaning of ice rink washrooms, dressing rooms, showers, lobby, heated public seating areas and hallways and janitor room as required,
- Responsible for emptying garbage after every game and ordering janitorial supplies,
- Casual hours on a flexible schedule as rentals will dictate the cleaning needs of the facility, and
- Evening and weekend cleaning will be required.


