

## Bylaw 12-2007

### A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF ALL TERRIAN VEHICLES

The Council of the Town of Dundurn, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


This Bylaw may be cited as "The ATV Bylaw".


1. In this bylaw, including this section:
  - a. "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
  - b. "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act and includes a road, parkway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;
  - c. "private land" means land other than public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
  - d. "public land" means Crown land or any land vested in the municipality, as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
  - e. "traveled portion" means part of a highway designed for vehicle travel including the shoulder of the road;
  - f. "untraveled portion" means part of a highway not designed for vehicle travel including the ditch and center meridian;
  - g. "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
2. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on the traveled portion of any highway within the municipality.
3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any public land within the corporate limits of the municipality.
4. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any private land not owned by that person or a member of that person's immediate family within the corporate limits of the municipality without written consent from the owner of said land.

5. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any untraveled portion of a highway within the municipality.

6. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty imposed by section 32 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
