

TOWN OF DUNDURN

BYLAW NO. 3-92

A BYLAW FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE
AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM SIDEWALKS.


The council of the Town of Dundurn, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Owners or Occupants of property within the area of the Town of Dundurn shall cause to be removed all snow, ice, dirt and other obstruction from sidewalks adjoining premises owned or occupied by them.
2. The Council of the Town of Dundurn is hereby empowered to provide for the removal of snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from the sidewalks adjoining property of non-residents and all other persons who for forty-eight (48) hours neglect to clear sidewalks within the area of the Town of Dundurn.
3. The cost of any work done as provided in section 2 shall be borne by the owner or occupant of the premises and in the case of non-payment, shall be added to and thereby form part of the taxes on the land, with respect to which the work is done.
