

# Dundurn Sports Centre (DSC) Guidelines

## Entering the DSC

- ❖ Masks are to be worn by all public persons when in the DSC
  - Players and coaches can remove their masks once they put their helmet on to get on ice, please make players wear their masks when entering even if their helmet is on (as per SHA approved guidelines)
  - Exceptions: (as per SHA approved guidelines)
    - anyone who is diagnosed with a medical condition that may hinder safe mask wearing
    - children under the age of 2
    - persons who are unconscious or incapacitated or unable to remove the mask with out assistants
- ❖ Use the hand sanitizer that is located at the main entrance prior to going through the second door
- ❖ All persons entering the DSC must sign in, children and assistant coaches do not as all coaches will be required to keep an attendance record and must keep that record for 30 days (as per Sask Health Guidelines)
- ❖ No Food is to be brought into the DSC
- ❖ Water bottles are allowed but must be clearly labelled with the persons name and filled prior to entering as water from taps can not be used for consumption.
- ❖ All others who wish to bring a drink must have it in a reusable mug or water bottle.
- ❖ RC Club may enter and go directly to their area, please stagger your entry so that not all members enter at once

## Renters, Coaches, Managers and Players

- ❖ Groups must not enter the DSC until 15 minutes prior to their ice rental time
  - If a coach, player, official can not get dressed in 15 minutes by them self then please arrive dressed
  - If a player cannot tie their skates, please have them on before entering. If this is not possible then each team can have 2 adults to tie skates in the dressing room (should be the teams Covid reps)

- On entering the DSC, you must go directly to your designated dressing rooms and remain in them until told otherwise, there is a white board that will have what dressing room or rooms you are to use on it
- ❖ Groups must exit the building with in 15 minutes of ice rental end time
- ❖ Teams must designate 1 to 4 people to be the Covid Manager/Rep who will ensure people follow these guidelines and:
  - Ensure that teams do not enter before their 15 minutes prior to rental and exit with in the 15 minutes after their ice time
  - Ensures all persons who are required to sign in according to these guidelines do so and that all participants and spectators are wearing a face mask when they are supposed to
  - Make sure nothing was left behind in dressing rooms and that any garbage left is picked up, there are garbage cans in each room

## Spectator Limits/Guidelines

- ❖ All spectators/parents must wear a mask well in the DSC
- ❖ All spectators/parents must not enter the DSC until 5 minutes before the scheduled time and must exit immediately after through the designated exit door in the arena
- ❖ No spectators/parents are permitted to be in the common area except for entering and using washrooms
- ❖ Maximum of 1 spectator per player for minor hockey groups who are sanctioned under Saskatchewan Hockey Association
  - For all groups who are not sanctioned under Saskatchewan Hockey Association the max is 30 spectators
- ❖ All spectators/parents are to social distance at all times

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- ❖ Spectators/Parents must sign in on entering the DSC with Name, Date, Time, and Phone Number
  - These records will be kept for One (1) Month and will be used if COVID-19 contact tracing needs to be done
- ❖ Spectators/parents will enter the building, sign in and immediately enter the seating inside the arena. Please follow signs.

## On Ice Maximum Participants

- ❖ Practices = One (1) Team
- ❖ Split Ice Practices = Two (2) Teams
- ❖ Games = Two (2) Teams
- ❖ For Spilt Ice Maximum of 30 people per side
  - COVID Reps or on ice officials must set up in away to only allow one group to come up at a time as to stagger the entry and exit of ice.

## Dressing Rooms

- ❖ Dressing rooms will be assigned, do not use a dressing room that is not assigned to your group
- ❖ **NO SHOWERS ARE TO BE USED**
- ❖ Each dressing room will be sanitized after each group
- ❖ Parents should not be going down to dressing rooms, if your child needs help let the coach know before hand and they will help or assign a COVID rep to help your child

## Bathrooms

- ❖ Bathrooms up stairs are open, but are to be used by Rink Staff, COVID reps, spectators, and RC club members only. Coaches, players, and officials are to use the basement bathrooms

- ❖ Spectators who go to use a washroom must go straight there and then immediately return to the area they are watching from, do not stay in the common area for any reason
- ❖ RC Club can also use these washrooms, but must go straight to them and immediately return to their side

## Exiting The DSC

- ❖ Spectators must exit immediately after their groups ice time has ended
- ❖ Spectators are to only exit the fire exit door that is along the south wall of the arena (wall with sound booth)
- ❖ Players, Coaches, COVID reps are to exit the door that is east of the entry door, when coming back up stairs turn left and walk past the washrooms and then turn right and the door will be labelled.
- ❖ RC Club will exit when safe to do so through the same door as players, coaches, and COVID reps.

## Public Skate/Hockey

- ❖ Public Skate/Hockey participants must all sign in when entering the DSC
- ❖ Maximum number for public skate/hockey is 30
- ❖ Use the designated dressing rooms for putting on skates do not use chairs or benches in common areas
- ❖ Public ice times vary from day to day, please check the calendar for updated times at <https://townofdundurn.ca/dundurnsportscentre/>
- ❖ Do not enter the building until 15 minutes prior to the public skate times and all persons must exit with in 15 minutes of public time ending
