

WHAT: Pedestrian Safety Corridor Phase 1 – Pathway Project

WHEN: Present – September 30th, 2022

WHERE: Clark Street / Railway Avenue

The Town of Dundurn will be completing work to install a multi-use pathway along the road in your neighbourhood. This work will take approximately one month to complete, weather permitting and barring unforeseen circumstances.

Project Details

- Clark Street & Railway Avenue is Dundurn's busiest thoroughfare. The pathway is being installed alongside these roads to improve traffic safety for all road users as well as pedestrians and local residents.
- The first part of this pathway project will include clearing and site preparation; trees and roots will be removed and hauled for disposal.
- Once complete, construction of the pathway will begin. This will include topsoil removal, excavation, asphalt pouring, and the remaining necessary work to complete the project.
- The Town will work to minimize disruptions to area residents, businesses and visitors.
- Heavy equipment will be required to complete this work. Noise and vibration are anticipated. Stay clear of the work zone for your safety and the safety of workers.



Will there be traffic and street/driveway access restrictions?

Yes, traffic and driveway access restrictions will be in place.

- During the pathway work, the road will remain open to traffic however, access to adjacent driveways may be restricted. Please follow the signage that is placed prior to 6:00 a.m. on the day work is set to begin.
